So as many of you now know, the Burnap Farm had a complete loss with our Peaches this year. We have been working over 15 years to have a great Peach crop with different



varieties like free stone and donut peaches. Due to the very early spring and late frost in April we completely lost the crop. Peach trees blossoms are more sensitive to cold

than Apple trees blossoms. Because many of our customers have asked us to carry Peaches even if they are not homegrown, we have partnered with another local farmer in Seneca Falls to bring you great local peaches. So please continue to buy local New York State peaches and help out the local farmers. Stay tuned for news about our Apples.
